Whitlock partnered with the VCU School of Medicine to transform its new 200,000 square foot [James W. and Frances G. McGlothlin Medical Education Center](#) in downtown Richmond into an immersive, collaborative learning facility, with pervasive video and interactive touch systems throughout to increase student engagement.

The new center uses the latest technologies in its 12 floors of learning studios, conference rooms, simulation rooms, classrooms and a large learning theater.

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## Immersive Classrooms

The divisible large classrooms are equipped with dual display student pods, whiteboard capture, six video projectors, and an audio system with microphones for each seat to enhance collaboration.



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Learning Theater

This theater was created to provide an interactive learning experience for group collaboration and large lectures. The advanced control system allows the professor to manage the room from the lectern, or from a separate station in the corner.
